**JON SECADA ACTUALITY:** (1:00) "I remember vividly, we wrote that song in about fifteen, twenty minutes. It came pretty fast, Gloria had some ideas, some lyric, and melodic ideas and we were sitting around the room one day with George and Clay around, and Emilio, and Emilio had the hook, and then Gloria was singing melody, I was singing melody. Within fifteen minutes we had the foundation of the song down and luckily the thoughts and ideas as she wrote the bridge of the song dealing with the accident and everything, matched with the things that I had been thinking about her, and it was a beautiful bonding. I guess at that point that we came up with the tune really quickly and it felt very special, very inspirational from moment one, that we started coming up with the ideas for that song. Not only that, it was my first number one song on the charts and what I experienced, for me, that's just as important as being an artist... seeing somebody else do one of my songs and seeing, you know, being successful on the charts, that's beautiful."
